Annual School Year Fee for "drop in" afterschool programming for the '22-'23 school year Payments – cash, credit/debit, check (make checks payable to Boys & Girls Clubs of Spokane County). There is a handling fee applied to all credit/debit card transactions.



The Clubhouse school year program will operate between 2:30/3:00p.m. and 6:00p.m. Monday through Friday beginning September 6th, 2022. Check your Clubhouse schedule for current hours. Registration is available at both Boys & Girls Clubs of Spokane County Clubhouses or online at <u>https://www.bgcspokane.org/signup</u>.

All participants must be enrolled as current members of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Spokane County and have an up-todate account in order to enroll in the 2022-2023 programs and activities. A parent/guardian must attend Parent Orientation (for new and renewing members) each membership year. Please call your preferred Club to confirm Orientation options.

Payments

All fees must be paid on or before the first day of participation at the Club. Only complete registrations with payment will be processed. Failure to pay will result in forfeiture of program spot in future enrollments. Payments are accepted in person and online at <u>https://www.bgcspokane.org/signup</u>. Please do not mail payments. **All fees are non-refundable and non-transferable.**

Partial refunds may be issued at the discretion of the Club Director for extreme circumstances (Club closure due to weather, family emergencies, etc.) Parent/guardian may make a refund request in writing no later than August 31, 2023.
